English

In writing this term, we will be looking at the story 'The Crow's Tale' to aid our writing of a persuasive letter. Additionally, the children will also create a poem about what would happen if they were in charge of the world.

During our writing lessons, we will be focusing on adjectives, punctuation, inverted commas for speech and remembering our suffixes e.g. -ful, -ness, -ly. We also will be looking at techniques of persuasion.

Maths

This term we will be introducing multiplication and division. We will be making equal groups and learning how to multiply and divide in 2s, 5s and 10s. Using our division and multiplication knowledge we will answer word problems. We will continue to look at fractions of amounts, addition, subtraction and finding the missing number in aritmetic.

Science

Our science topic is everyday materials. By the end of the topic, the children will be able to identify natural and man-made materials. We will look at the suitability of metal and plastic for a variety of purposes. We will look at different products that can be made from wood and will be identifying different materials that are used for the same product.

DT

In DT, we will be learning how to join fabric in simple ways by gluing and stitching. We will used simple patterns and templates for marking out our designs. We will plan and evaluate the stage of making a hand puppet. We will understand how to strengthen, stiffen and reinforce existing fabrics.
