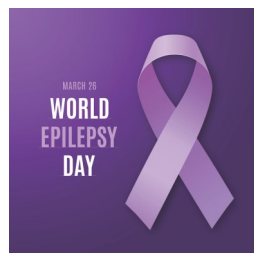


Spring Concerts

Key Stage 2 Spring Show – Tuesday 26th March at 2:15pm

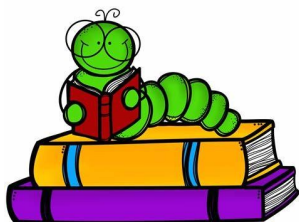
