

Summer Term 6 Year 2




English

In writing this term, the children will be writing a narrative based on the story 'Stardust'. They will be expanding their vocabulary and using an array of adjectives, adverbs, and verbs to enhance their writing. They will also focus on using the correct punctuation.

Further into the term, the children will be writing instructions on how to make a bird feeder. They will experience making their own bird feeder and then write instructions based on the method they chose!

We are reading...



In reading we are looking at 'Queen Victoria's Bathing Machine' and 'The Lost Homework'. The children will be consolidating how to retrieve using a variety of different question domains and practicing their inference skills based on clues from the text. The children will also focus on sequencing.

Maths

In Maths this term, we will be continuing to look at fractions. Afterwards, the children will be using their problem-solving skills to answer questions based on addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. Towards the end of the term, the children will focus on statistics and using bar graphs and tally charts to collect and analyse data.

DT

In DT, we will be exploring where our food comes from and looking at what forms a healthy meal using the eat-well plate. They will independently cut and grate fruit and vegetables as they will be designing and creating their own salad for a teddy bear's picnic. The children will also evaluate their salads and look at what went well as well as what they could do to improve next time.

Science

In Science this term our topic is based on making connections with topics we have already learnt. The children will be able to explain what reduce, reuse and recycle means. They will be able to describe how paper is made and will select suitable materials for a plant pot. Later in the term, they will make a plant pot from eco-friendly materials.

History

In History this term the children will be learning about the Victorian era. This will begin with an immersive experience at Holdenby House where the children will get to roleplay traditional Victorian duties. They will learn about Queen Victoria, what life was like for a child in Victorian times and what conditions they lived in. They will also experience what Victorian schools were like during our school History Day!

RE

Our focus this term will be on Christianity. The children will focus on kindness and explore when Jesus showed kindness in the bible. They will gain an understanding of how Jesus showed kindness to those who had let him down and were unpopular.

Music

This term the children will be having music lessons with Mr Baglee, where they will learn different notes on different instruments. They will play music collaboratively. The children will be playing their instruments and playing Beethoven no.9 Ode to Joy.

PSHE

In PSHE the children will be exploring how people grow, labelling the different body parts and gaining an understanding of how to respect each other's privacy.

Computing

In computing the children will be learning how to use tally charts to count and compare objects. They will be looking at how objects can be represented by pictures and using this knowledge to create a pictogram. They will also be looking at how objects have different attributes and using these to make comparisons.

PE

In PE the children will spend the first 3 weeks focusing athletics skills. This will be practise for the children's sports day where the children will learn how to sprint, balance and throw. They will spend the last three weeks of the term developing their sending and receiving skills. They will develop fundamental movement to be able react and move quickly.
