

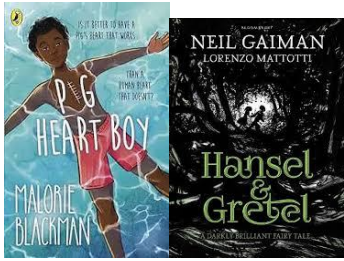
# Autumn One Term Year 6



## English

In English this term, we will be writing our own version of the traditional tale Hansel and Gretel. We will be focussing on effective descriptions and how to really draw the reader in

Later on in the term we will continue looking at traditional tales by writing a newspaper about the formidible criminal that is Goldilocks. We will also write a post card from an inmate at HM Fairy Tale

Our class reader is Pig Heart boy. We will also be looking at range of other text such as Hansel and Gretel, Cogheart

## Maths

In maths we will be looking at place value up to 1,000,000. This will also be in addition to rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000, and mental strategies for all four mathematical operations.

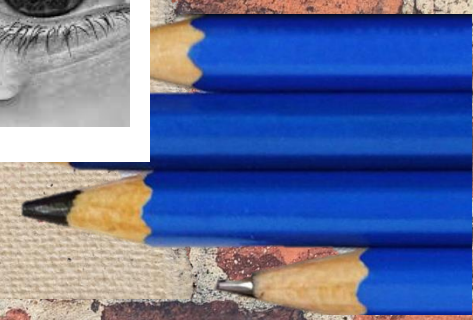
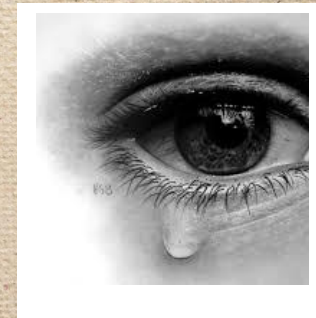


## Science

In science this term we will be looking at the circulatory systems. We will learn about the structure and function of the heart and our blood. We will also look at what we can do to keep our bodies healthy.

## Art

In art we will be learning about hyperrealism drawing. We will be looking at lots of, examples, including the work by the Spanish artist Hector Gonzalez. The unit will include exploring how we can use shading and perspective to make our drawings appear more realistic to the audience.



## Geography

In geography we will be learning about South America. This will include developing our map skills, identifying the physical and human features and a study on the Amazon Rainforest.

## RE

In RE we will be considering commitment with a focus on the religion of Buddhism. We will consider what is important to us and to other people, including some Buddhists.

## Music

As part of our enriched music curriculum, this term we will be working with Mr Baglee. We will be listening too and playing a variety of his music. We will learn about tempo and rhythm chords and work collaboratively to recreate the In the Bleak Mid Winter.

## PSHCE

In PSHE, we will be looking at relationships. We will look at recognising a range of feelings in others; how to report concerns of abuse. We will also discuss relationships that are important to us and different types of marriages.

## Computing

We will be exploring the world computer systems and networks. This will enable us to understanding the potential risks when sharing and transferring information and how to act responsibly online.
