

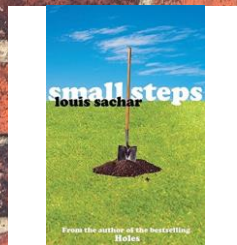
Spring Two Term Year 6

English

We will be writing a piece of narrative which is linked to our class read. We will develop the use of a wider range of punctuation in our own writing and how to use a range of different types of sentences.

We will also be writing a non-chronological report based on the last terms class read 'Holes' In this we will use a range of organisational devices, our own glossary and a range of punctuation and sentence types.

We are reading...



As we loved reading Holes so much, the children have asked for our class read to be the sequel 'small steps'.

In our reading lessons, we will be honing our comprehension skills by looking at a variety of test style questions such as using evidence from the text and describing an impression.

Maths

In maths we will develop our knowledge and understanding of: decimals, percentages and algebra. We will deepen our understanding of what a decimal is and how to convert between fractions and decimals. We will also begin to multiply and divide decimal numbers. We will also deepen our understanding of what a percentage is and how to calculate percentages of numbers. When learning about algebra we will be developing our understanding of algebraic expressions and writing our own equations.

Science

In Science, we will be begin to explore electricity. We will be learning about circuits and how to use conventional symbols in circuit diagrams. We will apply our investigative skills and explore how to change the brightness of a bulb in a circuit by changing the components.

DT

In Design & Technology, we will be using our knowledge of cultural and seasonal foods to design and make fruit crumble bars. This will include evaluating existing recipes and products to help to create our own.



History

In History we will be learning about the Mayan civilisation. This will include learning who the Mayans were and where they lived, and how their discoveries have contributed to our understanding of life today.

French

In French our unit will focus on WWII. We will understand better the rules of adjectival agreement in French and apply these rules to my work improving grammatical accuracy.

Music

In music this term our learning will be focused around exploring - Happy by Pharrell Williams: P. We will be listening to the music and learning to play a range of chords. We will also be following and identifying all the different sections of the piece, offering ideas to further develop the piece of music, and practising the final composition and perform to an audience.

PSHE

Our topic in PSHE this term is Keeping Safe. We will be learning to explain why emotional needs are just as important as physical needs are, as well as learning to explain some ways of making sure that I keep myself safe when using a mobile phone. We will also be Learning to explain why some people believe that more young people drink alcohol than actually do (misperceive the norm).

PE

In PE this term we will be looking at dodgeball. In this unit, we will develop and apply our stance and footwork through focused skill development sessions, modified/non-traditional games and sports and healthy competition.

We will also be looking at throwing and catching with Mr Roberts through cricket.
