English

We are looking at report writing and narrative.

We will be focusing on:

- Writing in short sentences using capital letters and full stops.
- Using finger spaces in our writing.
- Using Kinetic Letters.
- Joining two sentences using 'and'.
- Writing questions.

We are reading...



Children will read every day in their phonics lessons. We will be developing our fluency and pace. In reading lessons, we will be developing our decoding, explaining, retrieving, and interpreting skills.

Children should read **3 times a week at home**, and this should be recorded in their Homework logs each week. These will be checked in school on a Friday.

Maths

We will be looking at:

- Mass and capacity
- Multiplication and division
- Simple fractions

Science

We will be:

- Identifying plants in the school ground.
- Planning an investigation.
- Identifying parts of a flowering plant.
- Identifying, naming, and sorting wild and garden plants.
- Learning about deciduous and evergreen trees.
- Recognising that new plants come from seeds and bulbs.



RE

- Learn more about the Jewish faith.
- Think about special days of the week and how it relates to the Jewish sabbath and the creation story.
- Learn about how Shabbat is celebrated in the home.
- Learn how Shabbat is celebrated in a synagogue.
- To know what happens on Shabbat and think about what you would do on a special day.



Geography

- Locate Europe on a world map and understand where I am in the world.
- Name and locate the seven continents.
- Name and locate the oceans and make links to the continents.
- Use the compass points to compare the locations of different continents.
- Explore the human and physical features of Australia.

Art

We are painters:

- Learn about Vincent Van Gogh.
- Explore colour mixing.
- Identify primary colours.
- Identify and create secondary colours.
- Understand warm and cold colours.
- Create tints and tones.
- Use different techniques to apply paint.
- To design and create a final piece of art based on Van Gogh's style.
- Evaluate final piece using artist's criteria.

Music

We will be:

- Learn and recall a melody on chime-bars and a glockenspiel
- Play simple chords
- Count to keep in time
- Keep a rhythm at a constant tempo
- Follow music and simple notes
- Offer ideas to develop a piece of music.
- Practice and perform to an audience.
- Learn about the musical artist John Williams.

PSHCE

We will consider and discuss:

- What keeps our bodies healthy.
- How I keep clean.
- Recognise what I'm good at.
- Set a target for myself.
- Know how to stay safe at home.

Computing

We will be Digital writers.

We will:

- Use a computer to write.
- Add and remove text on a computer.
- Identify that the look of text can be changed on a computer.
- Explain why I used the tools that I chose.



PE

We will be:

- Develop sending and receiving skills.
- Send a ball to a partner or target with good accuracy.
- Position my body to receive a ball.
- Learn and apply athletic skills.
- Move at different speeds, distances and directions.
- Explore hopping, jumping and leading for distance.
- Develop throwing for distance.
